**Prayer: Their Plowshares Are Beat Into Swords** (inspired by Isaiah 2:1-5)

People: And you, in your indignation sound your mantra,

even while we dream of order.

People: And you, in your hope, sound your mantra,

"Blessed are the peacemakers."

Leader: Deliver us from excessive certitude about ourselves.

Hold us in the deep ambiguity where we find ourselves,

Show us yet again the gaping space

between your will and our feeble imagination.

People: Sound your mantra with more authority,

with more indignation,

through sadness,

in hope ... "Blessed be the peacemakers."

Leader: Only peacemakers are blessed.

We find ourselves well short of blessed.

All: Give us freedom for your deep otherwise,

finally to be blessed,

in the name of the Peacemaker who gave and did not take. Amen.
