Sunday School: There will be no Sunday school for children or adults for the summer. It will resume in September.

MCC SCHOOL KITS: On July 22, 29, and Aug. 5 we will be collecting school kits items for children in need from around the world for MCC distribution. All items must be new and never used.

The items needed are: 4 spiral one-subject notebooks: 8.5 X 10.5 inches with 70 sheets, 8 new unsharpened pencils, 1 ruler: flat, good quality, must indicate 30 m (inch indication is optional), 12 colored pencils in packaging, 1 larger eraser, 2 black or blue ball point pens, 1 small metal pencil sharpener.

Interfaith Human Services is organizing a unique fund-raising event named "Over the Edge" where "Edgers" will rappel off of the Fraser Street Hyatt building on **October 12**. Each member congregation of IHS has been asked to sponsor at least one "Edger" and raise \$1000 for that person to participate in the event.
