Park Forest Preschool annual Christmas Dinner Donations - It is a tradition for our church to provide the food for a Christmas dinner for each of the 35 families of children at the Park Forest Preschool. The Park Forest Preschool is a nonprofit, tuition-free school for two, three, and four-year-old children from income qualified families in State College and is one of the local organizations we support. At Christmas time we join with other churches and organizations to provide each family with a Christmas Box which includes pajamas, mittens, hats, a turkey and food to prepare. For our contribution, we provide the food for the meal and need the following: stuffing mix, turkey gravy packet, applesauce, canned cranberry sauce, canned green beans, canned sweet potatoes, and instant mashed potatoes, or a bag of potatoes or sweet potatoes would also be welcome. We also want to include children's toothpaste (new toothbrushes have already been donated).
