**Centre House**, a shelter for those experiencing homelessness here in Centre County, needs meals to serve their residents. Click HERE to sign up to bring a meal.

**Go Reentry Specialists** is a newly established, faith-based, non-profit organization serving individuals returning to the community after a period of incarceration. Through mentoring and support groups, it provides wholistic assistance, such as food, clothing, housing, and employment, as well as psycho-social support.

Go Reentry is mainly financially supported through a lawn care and handyman service called **His Workmanship** in which staff work together with program participants needing employment.

On April 11, Mark Frailey, the executive director of Go Reentry Specialists, and two members of his board of directors will be joining us during our Sunday school hour to provide a more detailed account of the program and its services. They also will be sharing their personal journeys of offending, incarceration, and re-entry.
