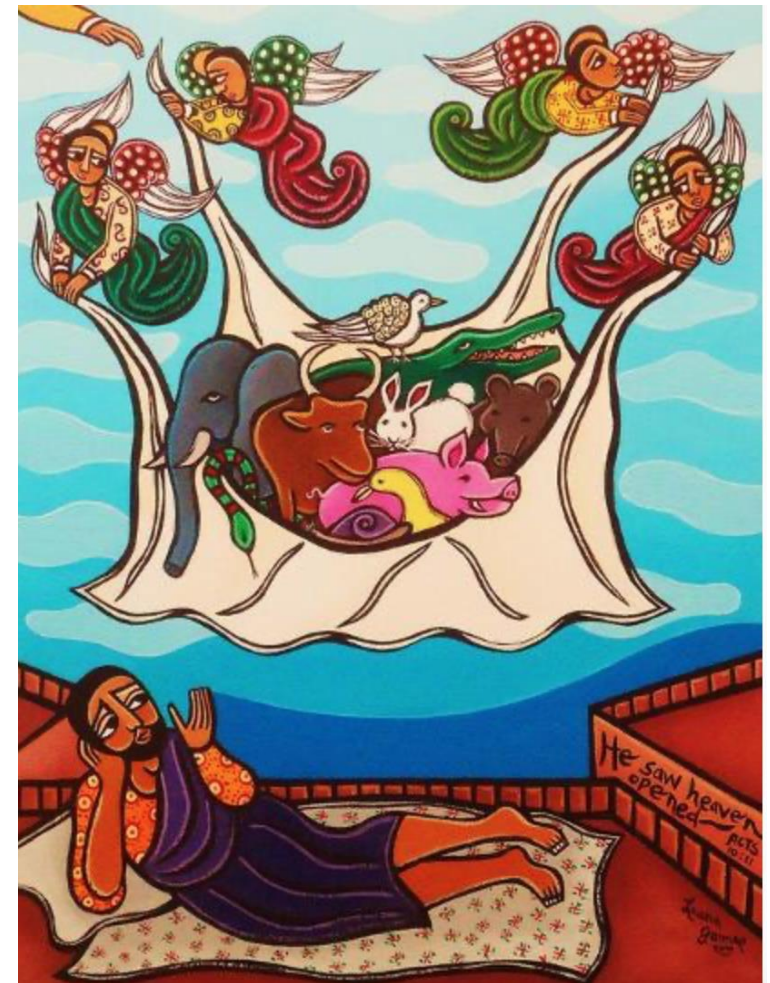

MCC school kits project - Mennonite Central Committee is conducting a school kit challenge to receive 10,000 school kits by August 31. School kits are the most requested item from MCC and last year they distributed 89,000 kits.

Our congregation has joined the challenge to collect the designated items. Today and August 20, bring your donated supplies to worship so the children can collect them during children's time.

Each kit includes the following items:

- 4 notebooks, size 10.5 x 8 with 70 sheets per notebook
- 8 unsharpened pencils
- 1 flat, flexible ruler that has centimeters designated
- 1 package of 12 colored pencils
- 1 large eraser
- 4 new black or blue ballpoint pens
- 1 all metal pencil sharpener (can be bought through amazon.com)
