### Announcements (cont.)

Creation care right here at home - The 75 solar panels recently installed on our building roof are creating electricity from sunlight and sending it back to the grid. In June we generated 3,600 kWh and in July we generated 3,700 kWh. That's approximately 120 kWh per day and at \$0.12/kWh it equals about \$14 a day. This summer we are producing more electricity than we use and are banking credits that will be used during the winter when electricity use is higher and the days are shorter. The panels are expected to last 30-40 years and were installed at a cost of \$56,150 (we received \$29,000 in grants to offset the cost to our church). Thanks to the UMC Creation Care committee for all their efforts!
