

COMPLETIONS

1. The carpets in the sanctuary and lobby were professionally cleaned.
2. The woodwork around the outside windows and the end of the church building with wooden siding were professionally painted.
3. The nursery bathroom was updated with a child-size toilet, a lowered washbowl, painted walls, and new flooring.
4. The large coat rack in the lobby was removed. Coat hooks were added on the wall at the Norma Street entrance.
5. Three benches were removed from the back, left side of the sanctuary to make space for the quiet time children's area.
6. A doorbell was added to the elevator door that rings in the lobby to indicate a volunteer is needed to assist a person using the elevator.
7. A viburnum bush, a native plant, was planted in the memorial garden area of the church building to honor our Native American people.

To be done as soon as possible, following the handicap guideline regulations.
