

Beginning today, UMC will offer Christian education classes for all ages following the worship service. All are welcome to intergenerational gatherings in the basement on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month. On the 2nd, 4th, and 5th Sundays, junior youth, older elementary, and younger elementary classes will meet in the basement and adults will meet in the sanctuary.

Join us each week on Tuesday at noon on Zoom for a curious, open-hearted look at the scripture for the coming Sunday. We ask questions of the text and ourselves, wondering what invitation it has for our lives today. There will be a congregational business meeting next Sunday following worship – The primary agenda item will be approval of the church budget.

Journeying through Genesis - We will be spending September through November exploring the rich and complicated stories from that ancient Hebrew text. Genesis is divisible into two parts: primeval history (chapters 1–11) and ancestral history (chapters 12–50).

The primeval history sets out the author's concepts of the nature of the deity and of humankind's relationship with its maker. The ancestral history tells of the prehistory of Israel, God's chosen people. We will be using the Peace Table Storybook Bible (https://shinecurriculum.com/product/the-peace-table-a-storybook-bible/) to structure our Sunday scripture and themes, and guide our children's times. We also recommend Genesis for Normal People: A Guide to the Most Controversial, Misunderstood, and Abused Book of the Bible by Peter Enns and Jared Byas (https://bookshop.org/p/books/reading-genesis-marilynne-robinson/19994788?ean=9780374299408).
