**Mennonite Central Committee (MCC) Hygiene Kits** – this is the final Sunday when we will be collecting items for hygiene kits for MCC. There are 5 items requested (new items only): 1 adult-size toothbrush (in manufacture's packaging), 1 large bar bath soap (in original wrapper), 1 nail clipper (good quality), 1 hand towel (medium weight, dark color, 16" X 26"), 1 wide toothed comb (6 to 8"). MCC states: *Thank you for limiting your generosity to the items listed. Due to strict regulations in some countries on the expiration date of toothpaste, MCC no longer asks for toothpaste to be donated with the kit. Instead, MCC will provide toothpaste with the kits when they ship from MCC's warehouse.* MCC has sent 80,060 hygiene kits to Salvador, Guatemala, Malawi, Puerto Rico, Ukraine, U.S.A., Zambia.

**Children in UMC worship** – Children through fifth grade are invited to come to the front of the sanctuary for children's time. After children's time, the nursery is available for children ages four and under. (Parents, please check to see if the nursery is staffed; if not, please stay with your child.)
