2025 Sunday school at UMC will include a mix of intergenerational gatherings and traditional age-divided class. On first Sundays, communion is extended into the foyer after the service with snacks and discussion questions for all - an opportunity for conversation with a variety of ages. On second, fourth and fifth Sundays, adults meet in the sanctuary, and there are classes for children in grades K-2, 3-5 and 6-8. On third Sundays, all are invited to the basement for an intergenerational activity. In January, we will alter this rhythm with an intergenerational gathering on January 12, followed by two weeks of traditional Sunday school. Sunday school will continue through the end of May and begin again in September.

We'll hold a congregational meeting on Sunday, January 12 that will focus on the vision for UMC. The meeting will be held, after worship, in the fellowship hall along with a simple fellowship meal. We'll hear from the visioning team and have time in smaller groups to help flesh out in table groups what our vision looks like at UMC. All are invited.
