

#### Announcements (cont.)

This is an update from the State College Interfaith Group (made up of 3 congregations - University Baptist and Brethren Church, Congregation Brit Shalom, and University Mennonite Church) who worked together with Church World Service (CWS) a few years ago to resettle a family from Afghanistan to State College. While we had hoped to welcome another refugee family to our area this year, that is no longer possible. Rather, we'll be stepping into the role of developing and coordinating remote ESL work with the refugees CWS has recently welcomed to the Harrisburg area. This is a big task, and one for which CWS has lost staff and funding. We believe that this is a valuable way to be involved, using the gifts and resources of our congregations. At this time, we are seeking volunteers from our three congregations to be remote conversation partners. Volunteers don't need formal training—just patience, consistency, and a willingness to engage! We will provide the tools to begin one-on-one work with interested learners in the Harrisburg area. We will need lots of volunteers and are hoping to begin the process within the next few weeks. If any of you are interested in volunteering to be a remote conversation partner or to teach very basic English skills, please email **both co-chairs** Kathleen Stehouwer and Bonnie Kline Smeltzer

The UMC by-laws stipulate the periodic evaluation of the current serving pastor. **2025 Sunday school at UMC** will include a mix of intergenerational gatherings and traditional age-divided class. On first Sundays, communion is extended into the foyer after the service with snacks and discussion questions for all - an opportunity for conversation with a variety of ages. On second, fourth and fifth Sundays, adults meet in the sanctuary, and there are classes for children in grades K-2, 3-5 and 6-8. On third Sundays, all are invited to the basement for an intergenerational activity. Sunday school will continue through the end of May and begin again in September.
