



We're thrilled to welcome RAWTools back to State College, for their unique blacksmithing, transforming things that hurt into things that help us grow. Author and pastor Hannah Martin will be bringing our morning sermon on August 3, with her new children's book, *Sparking Peace*, available now from Herald Press. At 2pm in the parking lot behind St. Paul's UMC/Abba Java Coffee House there will be kids artwork and crafts, a blacksmithing demonstration, and info to learn more about local efforts to end violence in our community.

As we support our neighbors near and far in preparing for a new school year, there are two ways to get involved:

School kits are Mennonite Central Committee's (MCC) most requested item. Last year MCC shipped 52,481 school kits to Ukraine, Burundi, Chad, Malawi, South Sudan, Zambia, and United States. Our congregation will be collecting these items for the Sundays of July 31, August 7, 14, 21, 28:

*4 spiral, one subject, notebook. (8.5" x 10.5", 70 sheets each.)

*8 new un sharpened pencils

*1 flat ruler that includes CM

*12 colored pencils in its packaging

*1 large ruler

*4 black or blue ballpoint pens

*1 small, all metal pencil sharpener

Donations of pencils, crayons, glue sticks, pencil boxes, notebooks, folders and water bottles (new) or cash/checks to purchase supplies can be made.
