Quote to remove and replace the fellowship hall floor.

The vinyl tiles in the fellowship hall of the UMC basement need replaced. Hess Contracting Services can remove the existing tiles and replace them with vinyl composition tile according to the following details:

1. The existing tile in the approx. 1250 sq. ft. fellowship hall, and the approx. 160 sq. ft. bathroom entrance area will be removed and disposed of.
2. Existing vinyl wall moulding would be removed and disposed of.
New and similarly colored vinyl composition tiles would be installed by a glue down method. New tile to be VCT similar to these choices:

3. Transition strips at doorways would be re-installed or replaced as necessary.
4. Approx. 180' of vinyl wall moulding would be replaced and re-glued. Choice of almond, chocolate, or black. Example: [Flexco Chocolate 0.125-in T x 4-in W x 48-in L Thermoplastic Rubber Wall Base F40CT2P072 at Lowes.com](#)

The material costs for this project are estimated to be: **\$6,600.**

The labor costs are estimated to be: **\$9,000.**

Total: **\$15,600.**

Charges shall not be less than **\$14,000** nor exceed **\$16,500.**

Payment shall be due in full at the completion of the project.
